

RULES:

- 1. Any medium can be used, including but not limited to one or more of the following: crayons, markers, ink, pencil, color pencils, watercolor, acrylic, etc. If using chalk or pastels, the work must be properly sealed and finished.
- 2. Work directly on heavy white paper or poster board. **DO NOT FRAME.**
- 3. Artwork must not exceed 11"x 17". Color copies are made of winning works for public display and we cannot copy works larger than 11"x 17".
- 4. Please do not write your name on the front of the artwork--attach the form (see below) to the back.
- 5. Artwork is entered at your own risk. All possible care will be taken to secure work. The Festival is not responsible for damage or loss.

RETURN/PICK-UP: No entry will be returned by mail. Entries may be picked up from July 15 to 31, 2019, Monday through Friday, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Festival office. Please call before coming to the office. Work left after July 31 will be discarded.
