5. Entries should be proofread for spelling, punctuation, and grammar.
6. Please send two (2) copies of poem and/or short story. No entry will be returned.
7. Please do not include names directly on the poem/short story. Paperclip the form below to the work.
8. Entries can be anything that was written in the last year. Any creative writing is encouraged.
